

- "I began attending the International Conference on FASD in 2015, and I would classify that experience as careerchanging. I met for the first time, a number of adults with FASD, clinicians, and importantly, caregivers. I hope to be able to help children and adults with FASD lead better, more healthy lives, while continuing to learn from these capable teachers."
