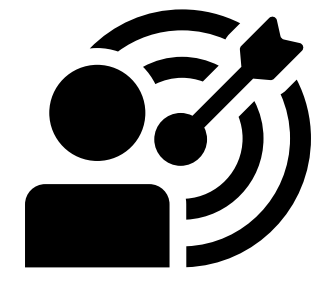

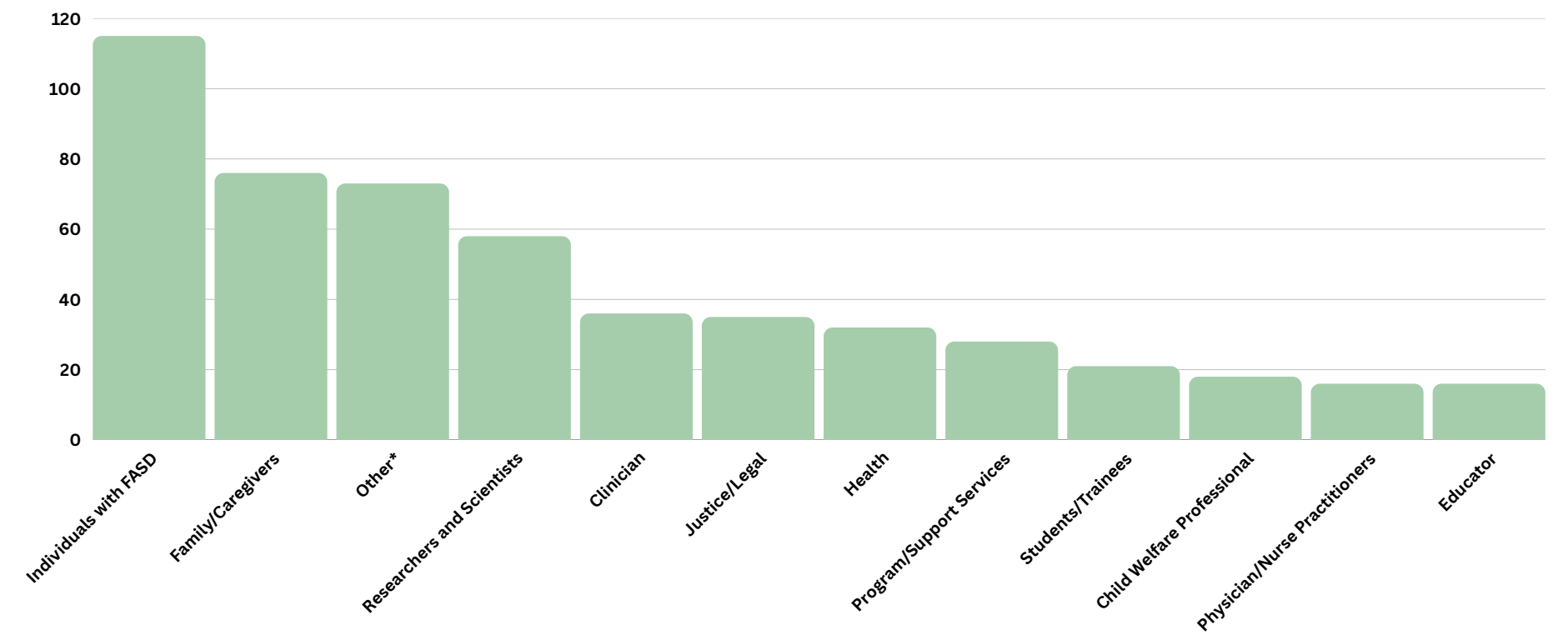


## TARGETED AUDIENCE
