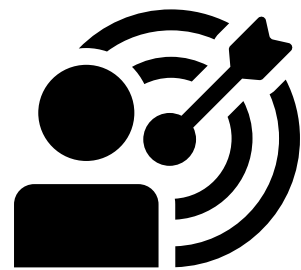

TARGET AUDIENCE ON-SITE

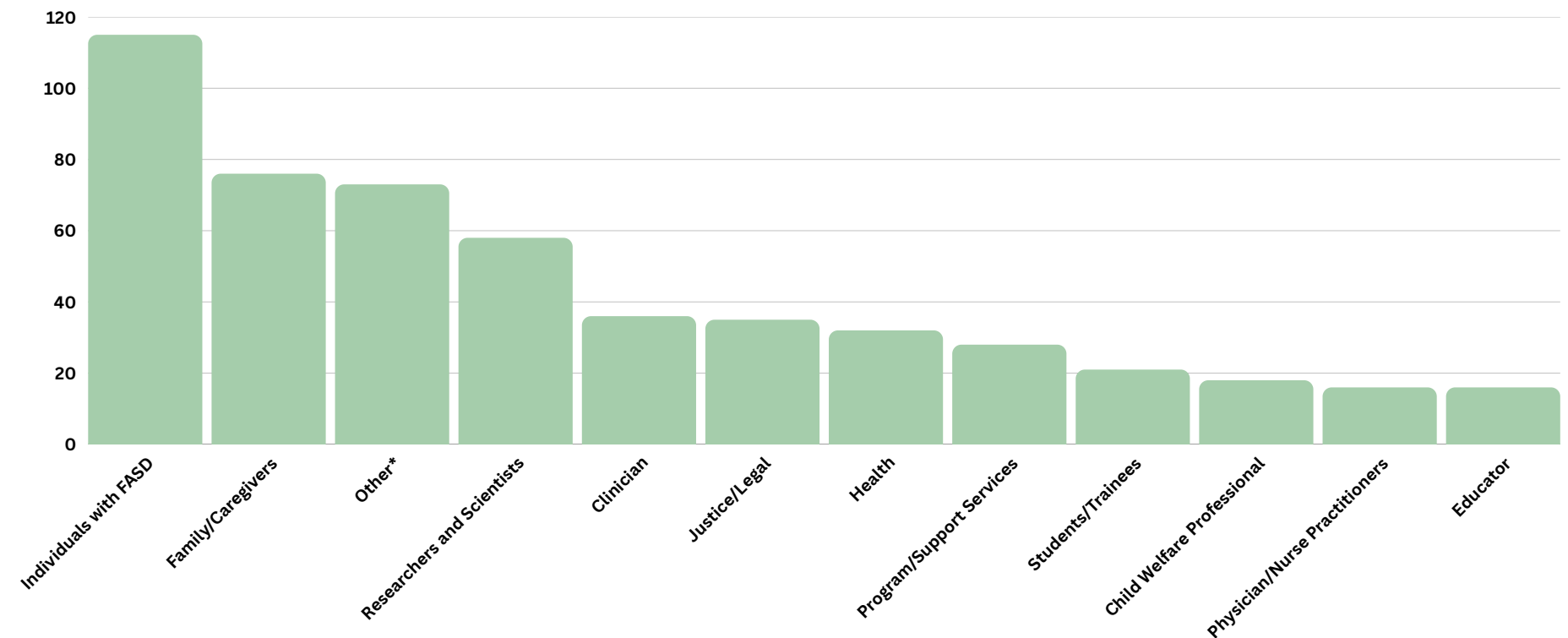


Being an exhibitor allows you to engage directly with these targeted attendees. Here is a depiction of the **top professions represented at the last conference** in this series, which took place in 2024.

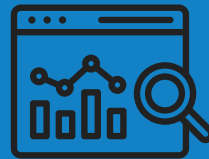
